Residential Energy Efficiency & Assistance Programs

Home Performance with ENERGY STAR®

Contractors certified by the Building Performance Institute (BPI) work with homeowners to identify sources of wasted energy and help make money-saving improvements. This program offers great financial incentives to help homeowners pay for recommended work.

New Jersey ENERGY STAR Homes

New Jersey ENERGY STAR Homes are built to be at least 15-35% more energy efficient than standard homes. New Jersey ENERGY STAR Homes cost less to operate and lessen the impact of power generation on the environment.

ENERGY STAR Qualified Products

Public education and incentives are available to promote home energy efficiency through ENERGY STAR products, which include lighting and appliances. A rebate is also available to properly recycle old refrigerators and/or freezers.

New Jersey Comfort Partners

Free energy-saving and education program for qualified low-income customers. We'll help you save energy, money, and make your home energy efficient. Certified BPI contractors install energy-saving measures. You will learn new ways to conserve energy, including an Action Plan to support your efforts.

COOLAdvantage and WARMAdvantage Programs

Incentives are available for energy efficient heating and cooling equipment, such as central air conditioners, heat pumps, furnaces, boilers, and water heaters.

Renewable Energy Programs



Solar Renewable Energy Certificate Registration Program

The SREC Registration Program (SRP) is used to register the intent to install solar projects in New Jersey. Registration of the intent to participate in NJ's solar marketplace provides market participants with information about the pipeline of anticipated new solar capacity, and insight into future SREC pricing.

Renewable Energy Incentive Program

Financial incentives are available to reduce the upfront installation costs for small wind and sustainable biopower residential and commercial systems.

Renewable Energy Manufacturing Incentive

Provides rebates to New Jersey residents, businesses, local governments, and non-profit organizations that purchase and install solar panels, inverters, and racking systems manufactured in New Jersey.

CleanPower Choice ProgramSM

A voluntary program that gives retail electricity customers the option to sign up for clean power directly through their local electric utility. Participants invest in renewable power technologies, such as wind, solar, hydro, and landfill gas without installing any equipment to their home or business. Enrollment means customers agree to pay a little more on their regular electric bill. This investment supports research and development of clean renewable energy technologies for the future.

Commercial & Industrial Clean Energy Programs

New Jersey SmartStart Buildings®

Provides significant financial incentives for new construction, retrofits, and equipment replacement including high-efficiency lighting, HVAC equipment, water heating, motors, and variable frequency drives for businesses, schools, and government-owned buildings.

Pay for Performance

Existing commercial, industrial, institutional, and multifamily buildings with an average peak demand over 100 kilowatts (kW) are eligible to participate. This whole-building approach starts with an energy reduction plan developed by an energy expert selected from our network of partners. Combined Heat and Power (CHP) projects are eligible for additional incentives as part of Pay for Performance. New construction projects over 50,000 sq. ft. are also eligible for incentives. Buildings must achieve a 15% energy savings compared to ASHRAE standards.

Local Government Energy Audit

Nonprofit, college, university, and local government-owned facilities including offices, courtrooms, town halls, police and fire stations, sanitation buildings, transportation structures, schools, and community centers are eligible. Participants select from a list of prequalified firms and receive an investment grade audit. The program subsidizes 100% of the audit's cost.

Benchmarking

Benchmarking provides energy managers with a building energy performance assessment and valuable information on how to get an energy efficiency project started. This free service is available for specific building types including hospitals and healthcare, municipalities, industries, hospitality, multifamily, higher education, K-12 public schools, retail and other commercial facilities.

Direct Install

Smaller buildings with peak demand of 100 kW or less receive financial incentives for qualified energy efficiency retrofits recommended and installed by a participating contractor. Incentives cover 60% of the installed cost, subject to a \$50,000 cap on each project.
